<p>Counselor</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ A licensee must complete at least 4 hours of continuing education in ethics, two of which must be directly related to Texas LPC ethics, each renewal period. <p>Marriage and Family Therapist</p>	<p>Of the total clock hours:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ at least 6 hours must be in professional ethics (see Ethics/Boundaries courses) ➤ at least 3 hours must be in clinical supervision education, if the licensee is a board-approved supervisor (see Supervision courses) ➤ A therapist who uses technology-assisted services must maintain documentation of academic preparation and supervision in the use of technology-assisted services as part of the therapist's academic program or the substantial equivalent provided through at least 15 hours of continuing education and 2 hours every subsequent renewal period.
